What is a Drive-By Shooting?

A drive-by shooting is a type of assault that typically involves the perpetrator firing a weapon from within a motor vehicle and then fleeing.

Drive-by shootings are designed to terrorize, intimidate and are usually retaliatory in nature.

The perpetrators have no regard for innocent bystanders, children playing in the street, or police officers in the area. They are focused on their target only.

Drive-by shootings are a symptom of overall gun violence that will take both the police and community members to combat.
