2018 Refuse/Bulk and Recycling Pickup Schedule

Every other week on the same day as your scheduled trash collection, recycling crews will collect bottles, cans, newspaper, magazines, catalogs, paperboard, white office paper, junk mail, phone books and mixed paper commingled in blue plastic bags, or clearly marked blue recycling containers not exceeding 35 gallons in size. Corrugated cardboard must be flattened and tied in bundles not exceeding 5 feet. Refuse and bulk pickup every week.

When a holiday falls on or before your collection day, your pickup will be one day later.

All items for pickup must be set out no earlier than 6:00 PM on the night before collection and no later than 6:00 AM the day of collection. Trash must be stored in containers with tight-fitting lids. All trash cans used for set out must not exceed 35 gallons in size and must be removed from the curb after collection on your pickup day (City code 619). SNOW MUST BE REMOVED FROM SIDEWALKS WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER EACH SNOWFALL. PLEASE DO NOT PLOW SNOW, SLEET OR ICE AGAINST GARBAGE RECEPTACLES. PLEASE DO NOT RAKE LEAVES INTO THE STREET; THEY CLOG THE SEWER AND CREATE HAZARDS.
