Announcements/General Discussion

Wickesberg motions to approve September and October meeting minutes; Canning seconds. Motion passes.

Jeff Martin from the office of Councilwoman Darlene Harris announced that council has begun taking requests for the 2019 paving list. Ms. Harris has allocated \$5k in the 2019 budget for air quality monitors in West Park. ShotSpotter is now operational in all of Zone I. A post-agenda meeting on proposed gun control legislation will be held following the January 26 council meeting.

Kimmel motions to request Councilwoman Harris investigate removal of median along North Ave such that left turn may be made from all side streets; seconded by Charleton. Motion passes; Dexter to write request.

Molly Onufer from the Office of Community Affairs made a number of announcements.

Jane Miller from Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy presented on the state of Parks in the city. Residents were asked to complete a survey that can be found online.

Dexter briefed residents on status of AllegHENY Circle Ring Road project. Construction scheduled to begin in 2020.

Dexter announced HealthyRide, Pittsburgh's bikeshare operator, is requesting to install two new bikeshare stations in the neighborhood. Mucha motions to approve letter of support; Green seconds. Motion passes.
