Discussion held amongst meeting attendees, including instruction from Dexter that only those who are ACCA members with current dues in good standing may vote. Dexter called vote and motion failed. Dexter motions to accept minutes as posted on ACCA website for review. Motion passed.

Erin Tobin and Susan Rademacher from Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy made a brief presentation on progress with the Allegheny Commons North Promenade project. PPC requested letter of support in favor of the project in front of the historic review and art commissions. John Canning motioned to approve; seconded by Beth Bouramund. Motion passed.

Pastor Ken Turnbull from Allegheny Center Alliance Church presented an update on their expansion. Plans for the frontage have been modified based on community feedback from the November presentation.
